The NMSDC affiliate council nearest a company's headquarters conducts the annual certification process to assure that the business is at least 51 percent owned, operated and controlled by minorities: Asian, Black, Hispanic and Native American, Our standardized procedures assure consistent, identical review for the certification of each MBF. Wherever your business interests, NMSDC certification guarantees national recognition. Certified MBEs are listed in the NMSDC national database, which is accessible to corporate members 24 hours a day, every day of the year.


